VARSAITY FOOTBALL: Varsity football will play Cy-Fair at 7:00 pm on Friday, August 31, 2018, at Ken Pridgeon Stadium. Tickets will only be sold online, <https://www.etix.com/ticket/p/4340981/cy-fair-vswoodlands-awaypridgeon-houston-cypressfairbanks-isd-football>, or at the gate. Pre-sell tickets will be on sale beginning on Monday, August 27, 2018. Prices are \$4 for Students and \$7 for adults. All tickets sold at the gate are \$8. Tickets may be accessed through email or a mobile device. A clear bag policy is in place at the stadium. Any fully transparent bage is allowed with no size limitation. Non-transparent bags must not exceed 6" x 9" x 5".

ATTENDANCE: TWHS classes begin at 7:20 a.m. and are dismissed at 2:35 p.m. Students who arrived between 7:21 and 7:35 are considered tardy. Those who arrive at 7:36, or later, are considered absent from their first class of the day. Please remember, students who arrive at school after 7:35 need to check in through the Attendance Office and have a parent note (or phone call) providing a reason for the absence.

Parking privileges are affected by 1st/5th period (2nd/6th for late arrival students) tardies and unexcused absences. Five-day parking privilege suspension will be levied after five tardies or three unexcused absences for those periods.

If it is necessary for your student to leave campus prior to the 2:35 dismissal time, please send a note with them in the morning, stating the time they need to check out and the reason for leaving. He or she will exchange the parent note for a Permit to Leave form, in the Attendance Office, upon arrival in the morning, between classes or during lunch. Juniors and Seniors who drive to school may check themselves out provided they have a parent note authorizing them to do so. By making arrangements in advance, we are able to minimize disruption of class instruction and provide an efficient check out at your designated time.

NINTH GRADE PSAT - For your child's convenience, the PSAT will be offered at the Ninth Grade Campus on Wednesday, October 10, during the school day. The PSAT/NMSQT is the Preliminary SAT test. The PSAT test is optional and available to all interested freshmen. It is recommended for students who are currently enrolled in geometry or algebra II as freshmen. The cost of the test is \$17. The Woodlands High School has purchased a limited number of exams for freshmen to take. Registration will continue through September 26, or until all exams have been sold.
