**TWHS SUMMER INFORMATION:** It is hard to believe it is almost time for school and the freshman year to begin. The teachers and staff at TWHS Ninth Grade Campus look forward to working with the Class of 2023 to continue the Highlander tradition of excellence. Included in this newsletter is information you will need to have a great start to the freshman year.

**ORIENTATION:** Freshman orientation for the Class of 2023 is scheduled for Friday, August 2, 2019, at TWHS Ninth Grade Campus. Orientation is a come and go schedule from 11 am to 3 pm. Freshmen will be able to pick up their schedules, locker assignments, and have their picture made for their identification cards if they haven't already. Various clubs and organizations will be represented at Orientation.

**SCHEDULES:** Students will receive their schedule at Orientation. Your student should take a close look at his/her classes to make sure they are the ones requested. Counselors will be available during Orientation to take care of scheduling problems. Keep in mind that students may be scheduled into one of their alternate choices because of a scheduling conflict. The master schedule is developed based on student requests made in the spring. Faculty has been hired to meet those requests. **Schedule change requests will be honored only:**

- 1. To meet requirements for graduation,**
- 2. To remove students from courses for which they have not taken proper prerequisite class (es),**
- 3. To remove students from classes for which credit has been earned.**

**Requests for changes that meet one of the three criteria above must be completed by August 9<sup>th</sup>.** All schedule change requests must be taken care of during the Orientation times. Counselors will continue to work on requests over the days remaining before school begins. If able to accommodate your request for the approved reasons, you will receive the change on your schedule the first day of school. **All requests will be reviewed.**

**HOME ROOM ASSIGNMENTS:** All students will report to Home Room on the first day of school, Wednesday, August 14, at TWHS Ninth Grade Campus. This includes students who have off-campus PE or classes at the Senior Campus for first period. Freshman home room assignments are based on alphabetizing the last names of students and will be posted throughout the campus. The Student Handbook will be available electronically unless you request a hard copy.

**YEARBOOK PICTURES:** Yearbook pictures are scheduled to be taken during students' English classes on August 27 and 28. A make-up day is scheduled during lunch time on November 7, 2019.

**SCHOOL SUPPLIES:** There is not a general school supply list in high school. Students will receive a list of supplies needed for their classes from each of their teachers the first week of school. Most teachers will require notebooks, paper, pens, and pencils.

**BREAKFAST:** Breakfast is served at school! School breakfast will give your child a healthy start to the day. A nutritious breakfast helps students be more alert so they can learn more in class. Breakfast has vitamins and nutrients for a strong and healthy body. Breakfast at school is affordable at only \$1.35. If you qualify for free and reduced price meals, you also qualify for the breakfast program, with no additional paperwork. You cannot find a healthy breakfast at such a low cost anywhere else. Help your child start the day right with school breakfast!

**NINTH GRADE CAMPUS OPEN HOUSE 2019:** Open House for the Ninth Grade Campus will be on Tuesday, August 20, 2019, beginning at 7:00 pm.

**FRESHMAN PARENT INFORMATION NIGHT:** Freshman Parent Information Night will be Monday, September 16, 2019, at 7:00 p.m. in TWHS (Senior Campus on Research Forest Drive) auditorium. Parents will meet the counseling team that will work with the Class of 2023 this school year and receive an overview of counseling services and information to you and your student as you plan for the next four years of high school.

**PSAT INFORMATION:** The PSAT will be offered at TWHS Ninth Grade Campus to those freshmen interested in taking the optional exam on Wednesday, October 16, at 7:20 a.m. Parents of freshman students will have to pay the exam fee. (CISD pays for all sophomores and juniors to take the PSAT). Students enrolled in Geometry or Algebra 2 are encouraged to take the exam. While scores students receive as freshmen and sophomores for the PSAT **are not** considered for National Merit, it is good practice for students for future testing. On the day of the test, students must present a photo I.D. More information for registering for the PSAT will be announced at the beginning of the school year.

**RED/GREEN DAY SCHEDULE:** TWHS and TWHS Ninth Grade Campus will be on the Red/Green schedule. A school calendar listing red and green calendar days is posted on TWHS and TWHS Ninth Grade Campus websites. Students will have 8 classes with periods 1-4 on Red days and periods 5-8 on Green days. Advisory will be held as an extension to second and sixth period classes Wednesdays and Thursdays. Students will not have Advisory on Monday, Tuesday, and Friday. Listed below is the bell schedule for TWHS Ninth Grade Campus. The bell schedule can also be found on our webpage. A student's lunch period is determined according to their third and seventh period classes. Students will find out which lunch they have on the first day of school.

**PARENT ACCESS CENTER:** Parent Access Center (PAC) is the CISD system for parents which provides online access to all your child’s class assignments, assignment grades, test grades, as well as attendance, discipline, schedules, progress reports, and report cards.

If you currently have a Parent Access Center account there is no need to renew your account as you have had to do in previous years. Parents can register for a PAC account from the Conroe ISD home page under the Student/Parent link. Student data will not be available until school begins. **PROGRESS REPORT DATES:** Every three weeks, updated progress reports will be available through Parent Access. Paper progress reports will only be distributed to students whose parent/guardian does not have Parent Access Accounts through Second or Sixth period. Paper report cards will be distributed through Second or Sixth periods on the dates listed below. The only report card that will be mailed will be the last report card in June. Parents may access their student’s grades on line via Parent Access through the CISD Webpage under the Parents/Students tab.

**DRESS AND PERSONAL GROOMING POLICY:** As you do back to school shopping, please take into consideration The Woodlands High School dress code when making your choices. Below are the excerpts from the Dress and Personal Grooming Policy for the 2019-20 school year:

Students are required to be clean and well groomed, and their dress must be modest and non-disruptive.

The following examples of dress are considered inappropriate and should not be considered all-inclusive:

- Hats/hoodies of any kind are not to be worn inside the building, by boys or girls. Hooded sweatshirts are permissible as long as the hood does not cover the student’s head. Students should not have hats/bandanas in their possession during the school day. If brought into the building, they must be stored in the student’s locker. Hats worn in the building will be confiscated and can be claimed by the parents or returned to the student at the end of the school day if it is the first offense. For subsequent offenses, items will be returned to parents only.
- Blouses or shirts of see-through material without appropriate shirt or blouse underneath are not permitted.

- Tops exposing midriffs, back area or cleavage are prohibited.
- Clothing with pictures/writing that has a double meaning.
- Clothing, badges, and/or tattoos, which display obscenities, sexual innuendos, depict violence or weapons, advertise or promote alcoholic beverages, narcotics, tobacco, or other prohibited substances, or items that could be viewed as offensive to others are not permitted.
- Inappropriate clothing includes any casual beach-like attire, including backless blouses, muscle shirts, off-the-shoulder blouses/dresses, halter-type tank tops, tank tops, tops with spaghetti straps, or pants, shirts, and sleeves that have been cut off. Blouses/shirts must be below the waistband when arms are extended overhead. Low cut blouse/shirts are inappropriate for school and should not be worn.
- Clothing of any type that is shorter than extended fingertips of the individual, whose clothing is in question, is not permitted. Slits on skirts, dresses, or shorts may be no higher than fingertip length (shoulders relaxed, arms extended at sides with fingers extended).
- Tights, yoga pants, or stretch pants must be covered by shorts, skirts, or shirts/tops that are of fingertip length.
- Undergarments must not show.
- Shorts, jeans, and slacks with inappropriate holes and/or tears are prohibited.
- Pants are not to sag inappropriately (undergarments must not show).
- All students shall wear shoes for health reasons.
- Sleepwear (pajamas, slippers) is not permitted for school clothing.

**ONLINE STUDENT REGISTRATION/DATA VALIDATION SYSTEM FOR 2019-20:** The Conroe Independent School District utilizes an online student registration/data validation system for the upcoming school year, powered by InfoSnap. The system is a secure and green process, which allows the district to verify all student demographic, emergency and medical information for your child prior to the start of the new school year. This online process replaces all the hard copy student registration forms that your child brings home on the first day of school.

You should have already received an email from the Conroe Independent School District with instructions on how to access the online system for your student. The email contained a link and a secure “snapcode” that links directly to your student’s information. Once you access your account, you will be able to submit an online information form for your student. To make the process easier for families with multiple students, you will have the option to copy all generic family information to all other students in your family.

We would appreciate all families to take action and complete these forms as soon as possible after receiving the letter/email. Your student’s registration will not be complete until the forms have been submitted. If you do not have access to the Internet, there will be computers available at the school to complete the forms.
