- Core teachers will make advisements for next year based on current work ethic, attendance and academic discipline demonstrated this school year. These advisements are a guide; however, parent and student make the final decision regarding course selection. Teacher course advisements will be made during the week of January 19th through January 22nd. These individual advisements can be found in **Parent Access (PAC)** and/or **Student Access (SAC)** under the 4 Year Plan tab.

- Due to the ongoing pandemic our Elective Fair will be virtual. It will include both pdf's and videos on many of our courses, both core and electives. Families will be able to find the link on the TWHS website. (the format will be similar to our open house earlier this school year).

- Virtual Parent/Student Help Session is Thursday, February 4th. The counselors are available to meet with students and parents from 4:30 – 6:30 pm. This session is only for families that still have questions regarding registration.

- A total of 8 blocks must be selected, or 7 blocks, if you select a double blocked course such as Band or Athletics. Choose a minimum of 3 alternates.

- Verifications will be available on student's Course Request Tab In both Parent and Student Access by April 16, 2021. If a student wishes to make a change to their Requests they can request a Schedule Course Change Form from the McCullough Counseling Center and return to their 8th Grade Counselor. Students can also email their 9th grade counselor with Course Request Changes.
